Signs of an Overdose

- Person is unconscious or not waking up
- Person doesn't respond to shouting or rubbing knuckles on breastbone or between upper lip and nose
- Person is not breathing normally
 - Breathing very slowly or not breathing
 - Snoring, choking or gurgling sounds

Take Action

1 Call 9-1-1

2 Give naloxone (NARCAN®)



3 If the person is not breathing after you give them naloxone, start rescue breathing and chest compressions.
